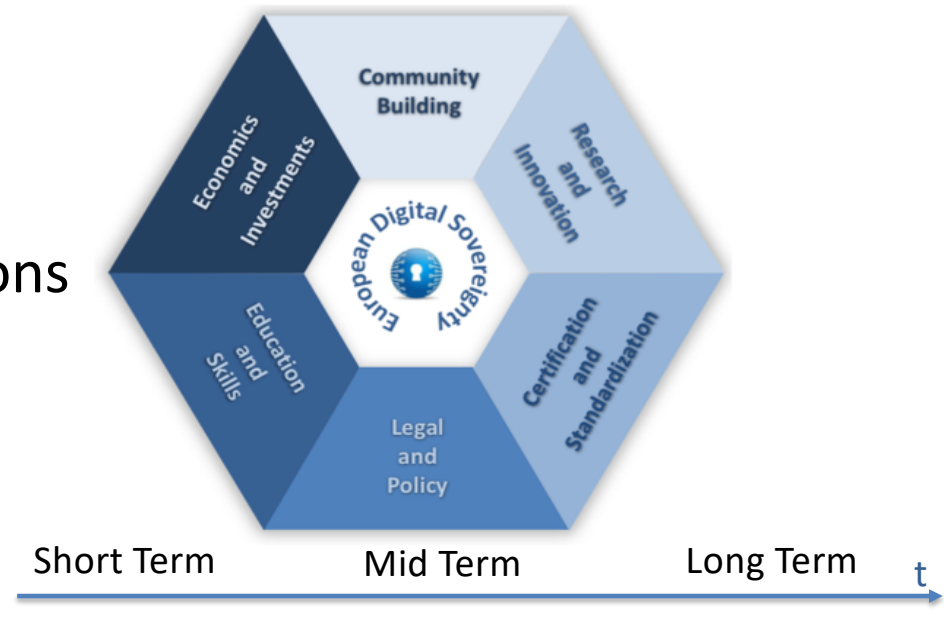

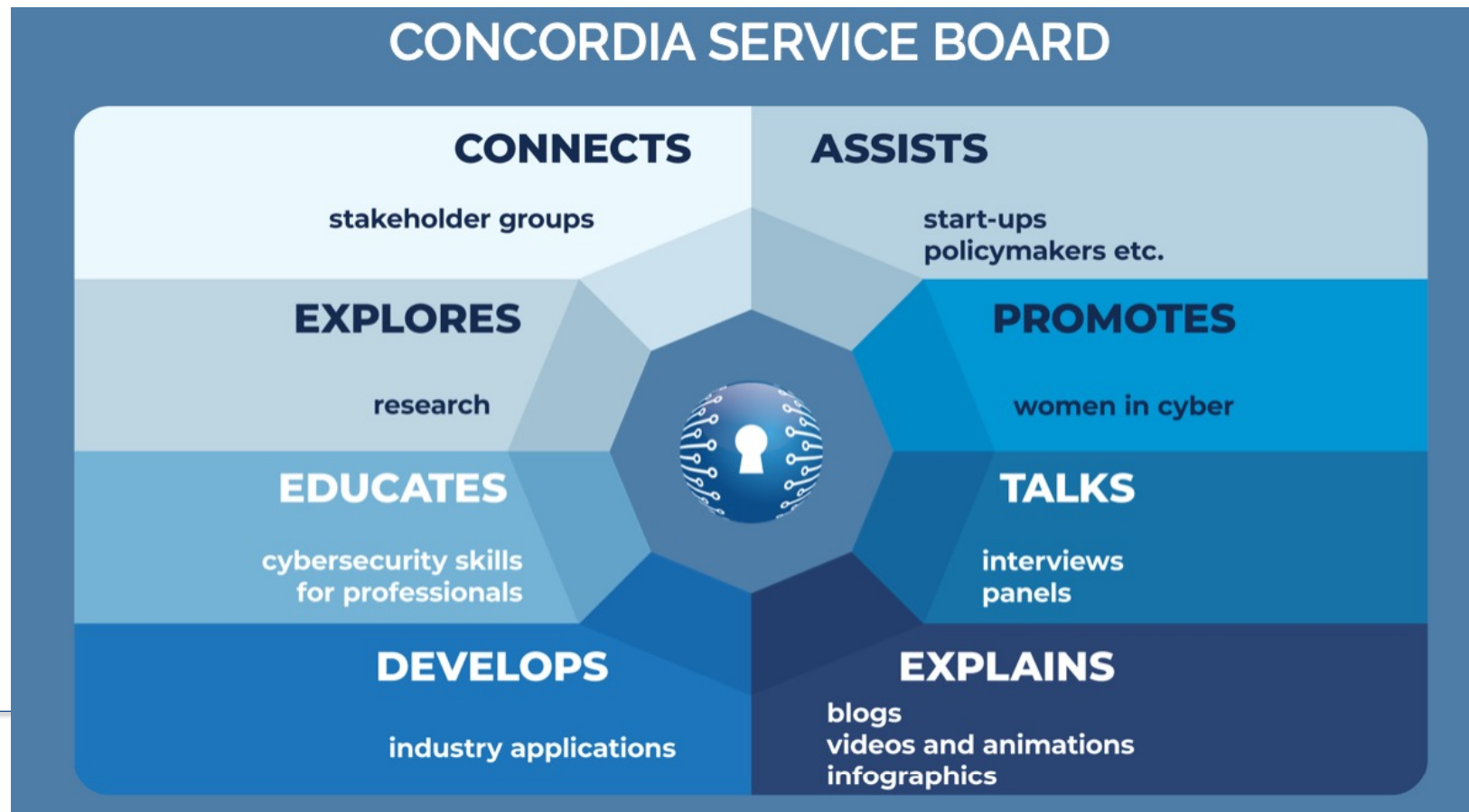

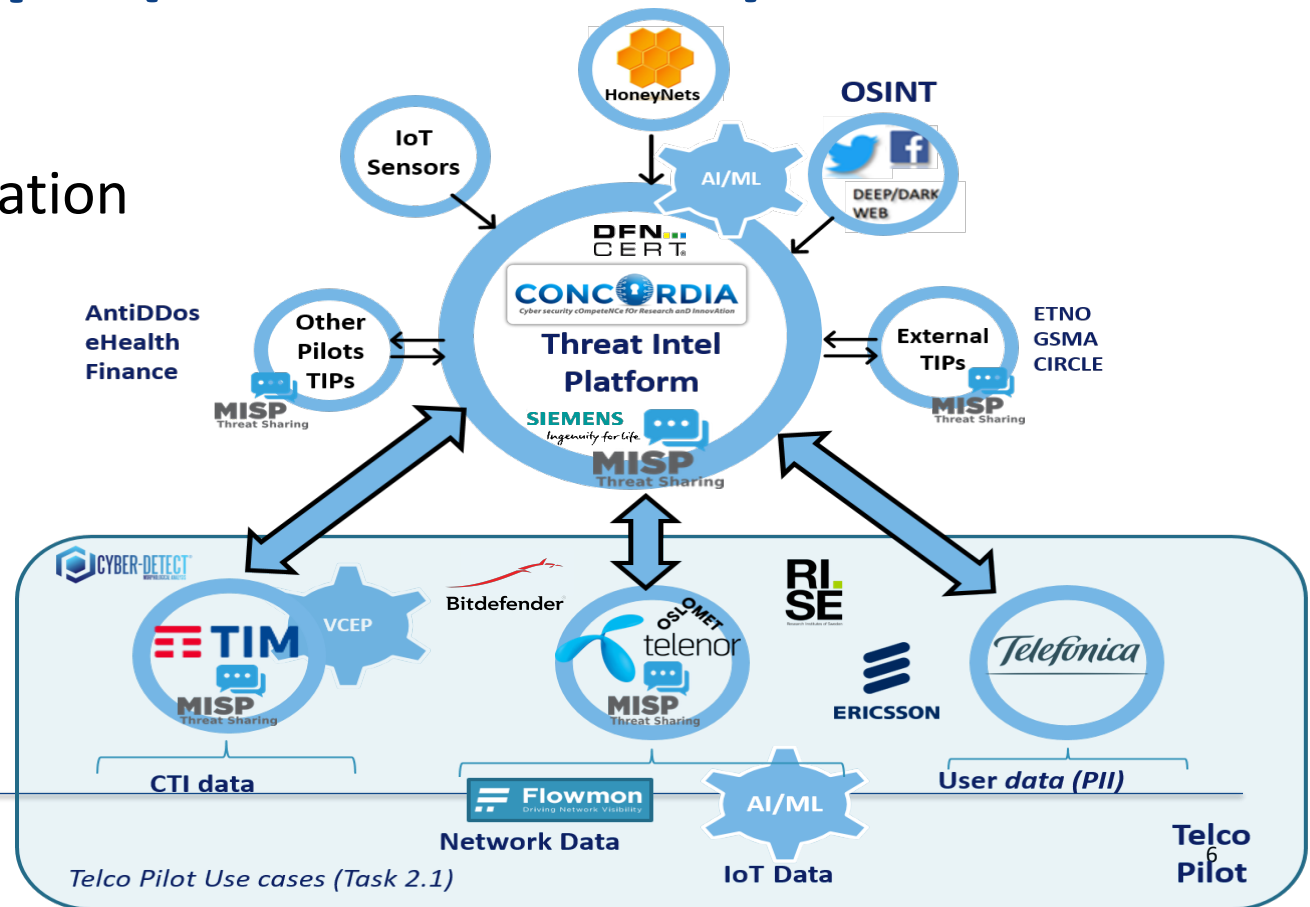
CONCORDIA's Service Board: Building the Community resp. Ecosystem
